

How to Access FAST Score Reports for Students in Grades 3-10

1.) Login into you Parent FOCUS Portal:

 - You will need your Student's ID Number and the PIN Number sent to you in the email you received. If you did not receive this information, please reach out to echilders@babcockneighborhoodschool.org
 - When you get in the first time, you will need to update some information in the system (Residency and Emergency Contact).

2.) Once in the system, look at the middle of the screen to find your student's schedule.

5.) Once you have been redirected, you will see a screen that has the assessments, reported through this platform, that your child has taken.
